## THUNDER and LIGHTNING PROTOCOL



- If anyone SEES lightning or HEARS thunder, the field is to be evacuated immediately.
- Leave items on the field. Everyone needs to go to their cars.
- Since all games are at Memorial Field, if one field evacuates, all fields will follow suit.
- If there is no occurrence of lightning or thunder in the fiollowing 15 minutes, the game may resume.
- If there is another occurrence of lightning or thunder, you must wait for another 15 minutes.
- If there is another occurrence of lightning or thunder in the second 15 minutes, the game is over.
- If the second half kick-off has occurred, the game is over, and the score stands. If the second half Kick-off has NOT occurred, the game is to be rescheduled. Confer with the opposing coach for an agreeable date, and relay that information to Bill Saenz who will reschedule the game. To honor your request or not is up to Bill. He determines the make-up date and time.
- If there is a REFEREE, he executes this protocol.
- Any cancellation of games occurs AT THE FIELD. The scheduled referee makes that decision regarding weather and field conditions.
- The only person that can cancel any game ahead of time is the COMMISSIONER.
