



AYSO CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

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These are the steps to follow when any player is suspected of a concussion or displays concussion symptoms after a blow to the head by any adult present at any AYSO sponsored event.

This includes practices.

Please review the attached Concussion documents

- The player is to be removed from play.
- Do not try to evaluate the player as to the severity of the blow to the head
- Inform the parents/or guardian regarding the suspected concussion
- The player is not allowed to practice or play in a game until a doctor's release is received
- Submit an incident report to the Safety Director
(scan and send as e-mail attachment)
(copy the incident report included)
- Submit the medical release to the Safety Director
(scan and send as e-mail attachment)

AYSO INJURY PROTOCOL

These are the steps to follow when any player has received an injury severe enough that they need to receive medical treatment.

This includes practices.

- The player is to be removed from play.
- Do not try to evaluate the player as to the severity of the injury
- Inform the parents/or guardian regarding the injury
- The player is not allowed to practice or play in a game until a doctor's release is received
- Submit an incident report to the Safety Director
